
HESI ADMISSION ASSESSMENT EXAM (A2)

Assess applicants' basic learning skills and gauge future classroom success

The HESI Admission Assessment Exam consists of seven academic exams, as well as a personality profile that identifies the individual applicant's learning style. Individual scores are provided for each exam, and the scores are combined to provide subscores in these areas:

ENGLISH LANGUAGE - 160 Minutes*

• Reading Comprehension (47 items) Provides reading scenarios in order to measure reading comprehension, identifying the main idea, finding meaning of words in context, passage comprehension, making logical inferences, etc.

Recommended time: 60 minutes

Vocabulary and General Knowledge (50 items) Contains vocabulary terms that are commonly used in both general English speaking settings and in health

care fields. Recommended time: 50 minutes

* Grammar

Contains basic grammar, including parts of speech, important terms and their uses, commonly occurring grammatical errors, etc. Recommended time: 50 minutes

MATH - 50 Minutes

· Basic Math Skills (50 items)

Focuses on math skills needed for health care fields, including basic addition, subtraction, multiplication, fractions, decimals, ratio and proportion, household measures, general math facts, etc.

Recommended time: 50 minutes

SCIENCE - 125 Minutes

Biology (25 items) Covers biology basics, water, biological molecules, metabolism, cells, cellular respiration, photosynthesis, etc. Recommended time: 25 minutes

- Chemistry (25 items)
 Contains test items that cover matter, chemical equations and reactions, the periodic table, atomic structure, nuclear chemistry, chemical bonding, etc.
 Recommended time: 25 minutes
- Anatomy and Physiology (25 items)
 Provides coverage of general terminology and anatomical structures and systems
 Recommended time: 25 minutes
- Physics (25 items)
 Provides coverage of physics for Radiology
 programs. Recommended time: 50 minutes

LEARNER PROFILE - 30 Minutes

- Learning Style (14 items)
 Assesses preferred learning style.
 Recommended time: 15 minutes
- Personality Profile (15 items)
 Assesses personality related to preferred learning style. Recommended time: 15 minutes
- * Administration times are suggested times only.
